



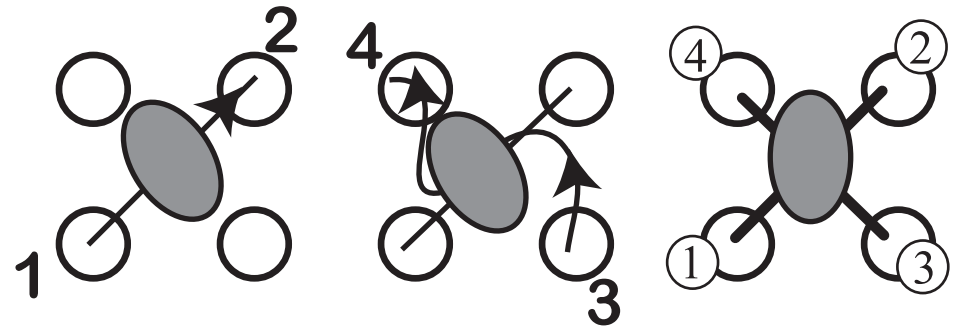
PETITE SEED BEADS size 15 (2mm)

CROSS STITCH

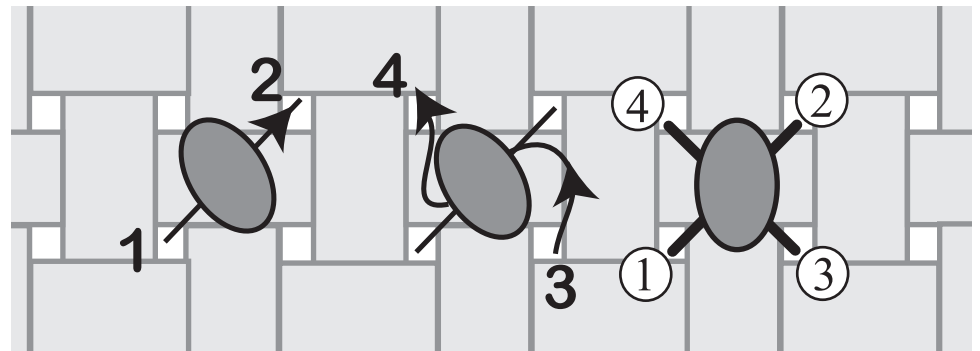
14 to 18 count - over one
28 to 36 count - over two

Larger than 14 count not recommended.

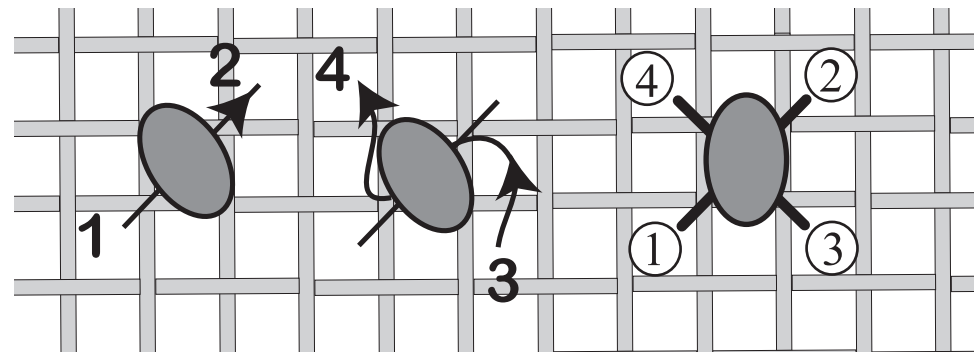
1. Do complete cross stitch with each bead before moving on to the next.
2. Be consistent with stitching direction.
3. Beads should lie vertically.
4. Do not jump more than three or four stitches without first securing floss on the back.



14 count perforated paper - over one



14 18 count Aida - over one



28-36 count linen - over two



SEED BEADS

size 11 (2.5mm)

HALF CROSS STITCH

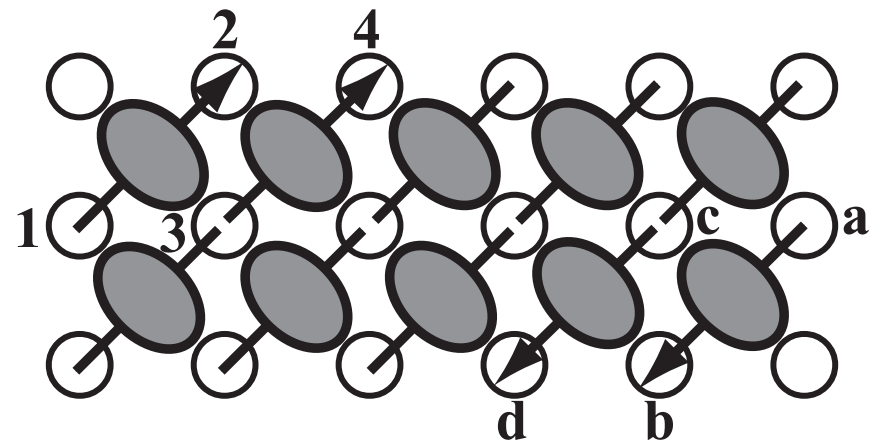
14 to 16 count - over one
28 to 32 count - over two

Smaller than 16 count

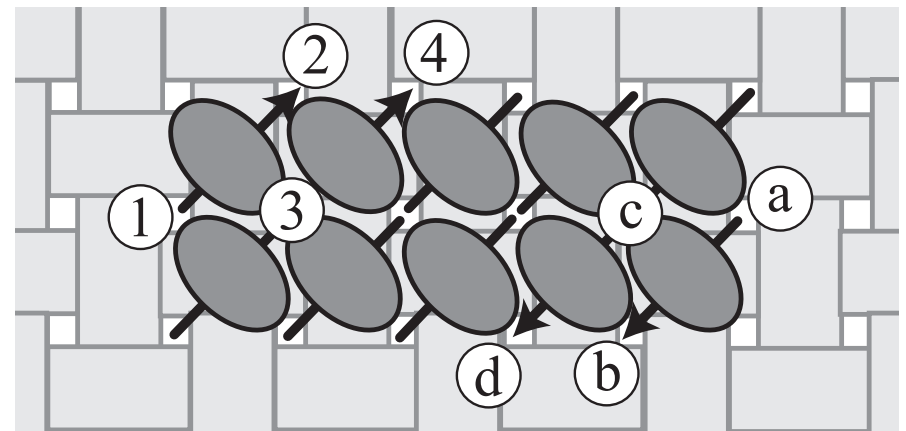
Can be used if beads are not next to each other.

Otherwise use Magnifica or petite beads.

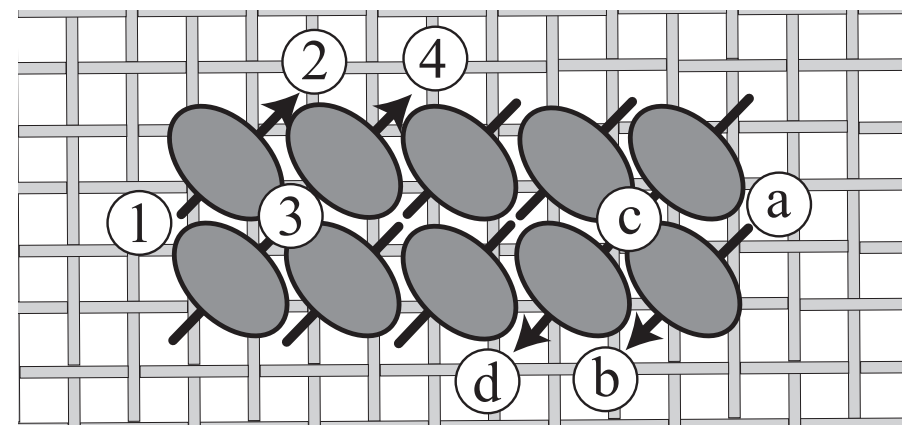
1. *Be consistent with stitching direction so beads will nest together and lie in the same direction.*
2. *Do not jump more than three or four stitches without first securing floss on the back.*

28-32 count linen - over two



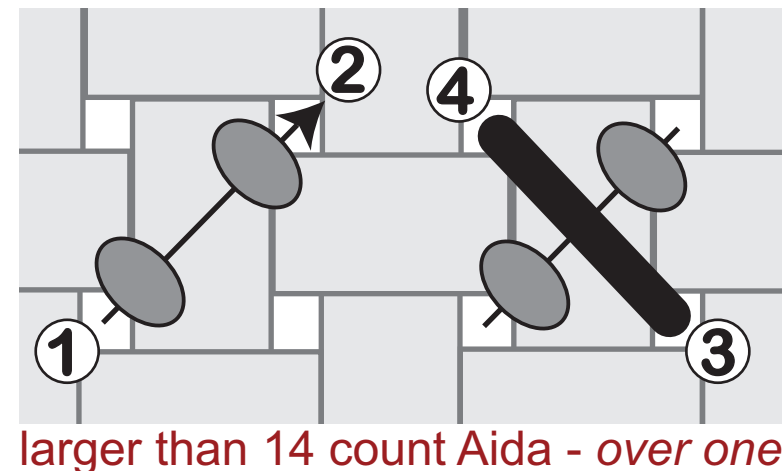
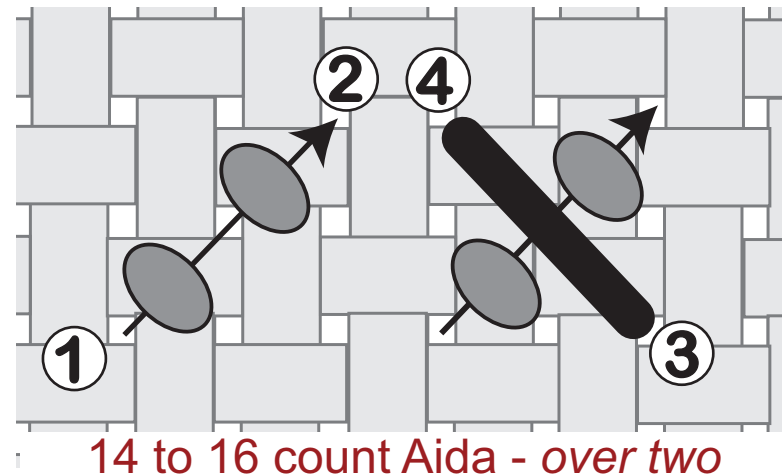
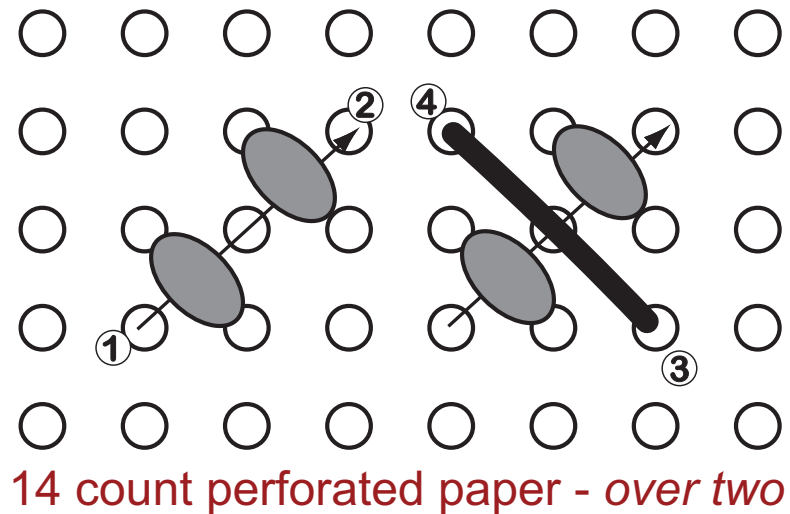
SEED BEADS
size 11 (2.5mm)

HALF BEAD KNOT
uses **two** beads per stitch

14 to 16 count - over two
28 to 32 count linen - over four
larger than 14 count - over one

Good for size 8 to 11 Aida where one
size 11 seed bead would not cover stitch.

1. Pick up two size 11 beads for the first leg of the cross stitch.
2. For the second leg go between the beads with floss.
3. Be consistent with stitching direction so beads will lie in the same direction.
4. Do not jump more than three or four stitches without first securing floss on the back.



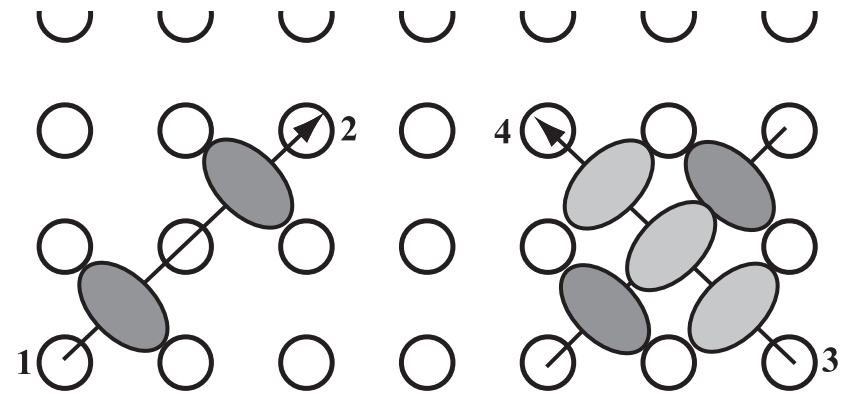


SEED BEADS size 11 (2.5mm)

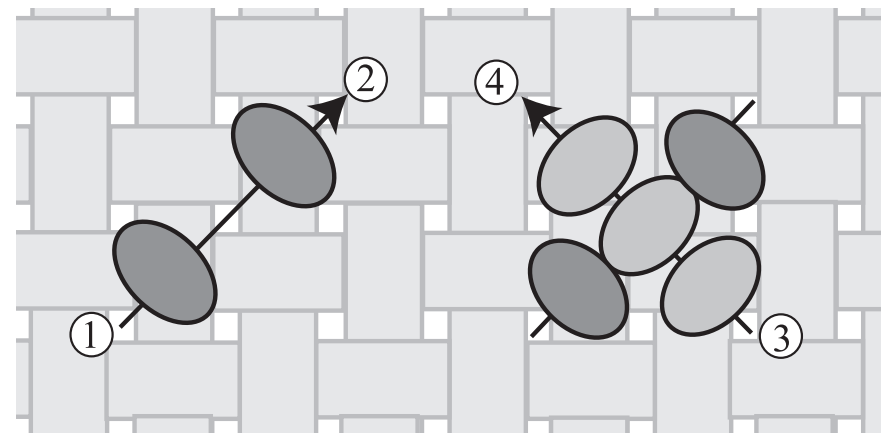
FIVE BEAD KNOT (POSIE) *uses **five** beads per stitch*

14 to 16 count - over two
28 to 32 count linen - over four
larger than 14 count - over one

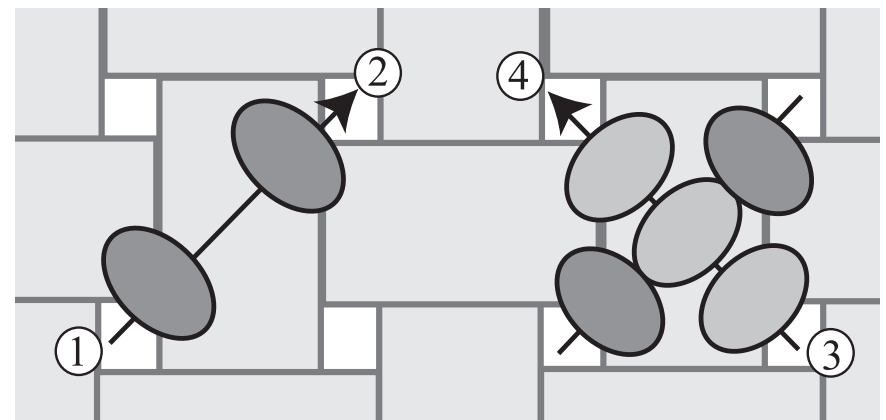
1. Pick up two size 11 beads for the first leg of the cross stitch.
2. Pick up three for the second leg go between the first two beads.
3. Be consistent with stitching direction so beads will lie in the same direction.
4. Do not jump more than three or four stitches without first securing floss on the back.

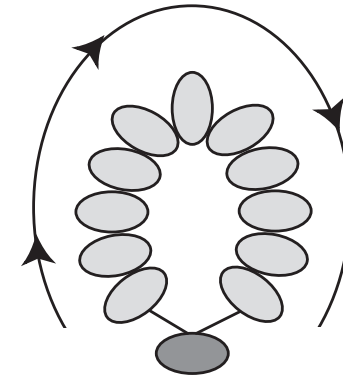


BEAD LOOP

Use five to nine beads

May use petite or seed beads.

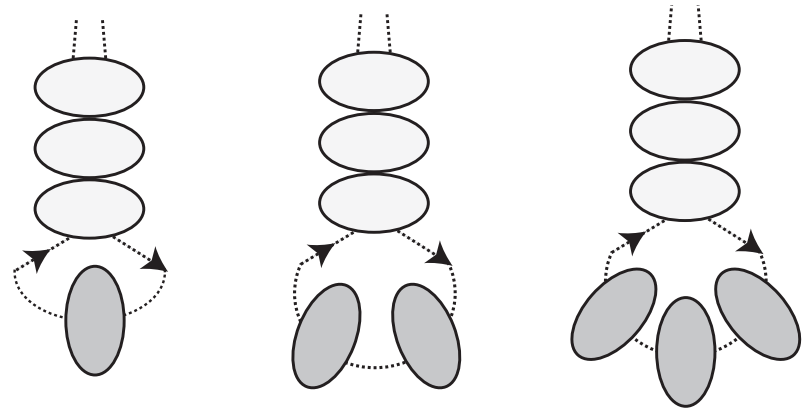
- 1. Pick up 5 to 9 beads.*
- 2. Return needle through first bead and through to the back of the fabric or perforated paper.*
- 3. repeat if making a bow*



bead loop

BEAD STREAMER WITH PICOT

- 1. Pick up number of beads to make appropriate length plus 1, 2 or 3 more for picot.*
- 2. Skipping the beads for the picot, return needle through rest of beads and through to the back of the fabric or perforated paper.*
- 3. repeat if making a bow*



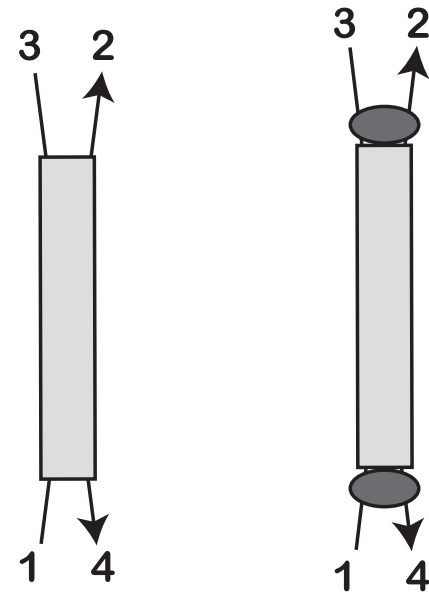
bead streamers with

small - 6mm
medium - 9 mm

ELONGATED ATTACHMENT

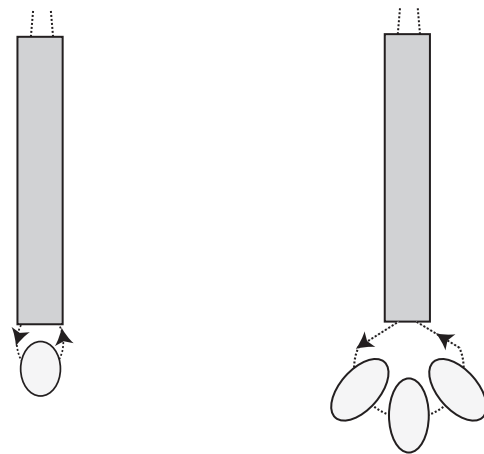
*Can be stitched in place of stitches
