

## FINISHED SIZE

Approximately 2½" × 2½"

## YOU WILL NEED

96 4mm crystal faceted beads\*  
 38 3mm silver metallic beads\*  
 24 10mm crystal starflakes\*  
 24 18mm crystal starflakes\*  
 26-gauge silver paddlewire\*  
 9" piece of silver cord  
 Wire cutters  
 Needle-nose pliers  
 Scissors  
 Hot glue and glue gun

## QUICK TIPS

1. Use needle-nose pliers to twist and shape wire.
2. Follow directions and refer to diagrams frequently.

## DIRECTIONS

Step 1: Cut six 6" lengths of wire.

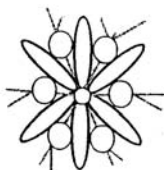
Step 2: Insert one wire through center hole of a large crystal starflake. Slide starflake to center of wire, fold in half keeping ends even. Use needle-nose pliers to twist wire snug between petals. See Figure A.

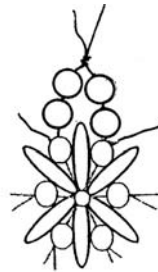
Step 3: Insert the remaining five wires through the center hole of the large starflake (wires will be a snug fit). Fold and twist each wire in between each petal.

Step 4: Bring ends of wire together from between one of the petals. Thread onto both wires one silver bead; slide bead down to fit between the petals. Slightly pull wire apart to hold silver bead in place. Repeat for remaining five sections in starflake. See Figure B.

Step 5: Use one wire from one of the petals and one wire from the next petal. Place two crystal faceted beads onto each of the wires. Bring the two wires together and twist just above the beads. See Figure C. Repeat for remaining wires around starflake.

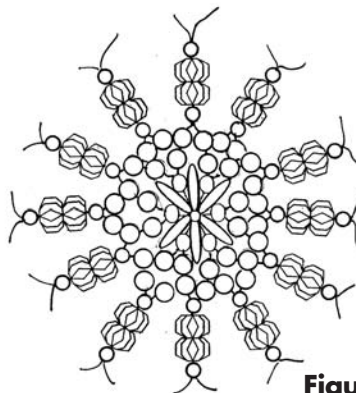
Step 6: Hold two wires together and thread onto both wires one silver bead, two small crystal starflakes, and one more silver bead; split wires apart to hold beads in place. See Figure D. Repeat for the remaining wires around starflake.

Step 7: Repeat Steps 1 through 6.

Step 8: Glue the two large crystal starflakes together at center. Make sure the arms of the snowflake are between each other. See Figure E.

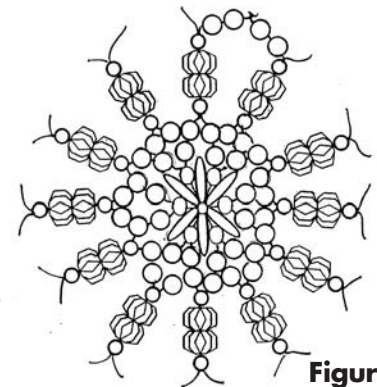

Step 9: Use one wire from one of the snowflake arms and one wire from the next. Place two crystal faceted beads onto each of the wires. Bring the two wires together and twist above beads. Trim remaining wire leaving approximately ¼". See Figure F. Use your needle-nose pliers to bend under the twisted wire so no sharp

ends are sticking out. Repeat for the remaining wire around the snowflake.

Step 10: Glue one silver bead at center of large starflake. Repeat on opposite side.

HANGER: Cut one 9" length of silver cord. String through opening between faceted beads and tie ends together.

CLEANING: If ornament becomes soiled or dusty, gently wipe a damp cloth over small areas until entire ornament is clean.
