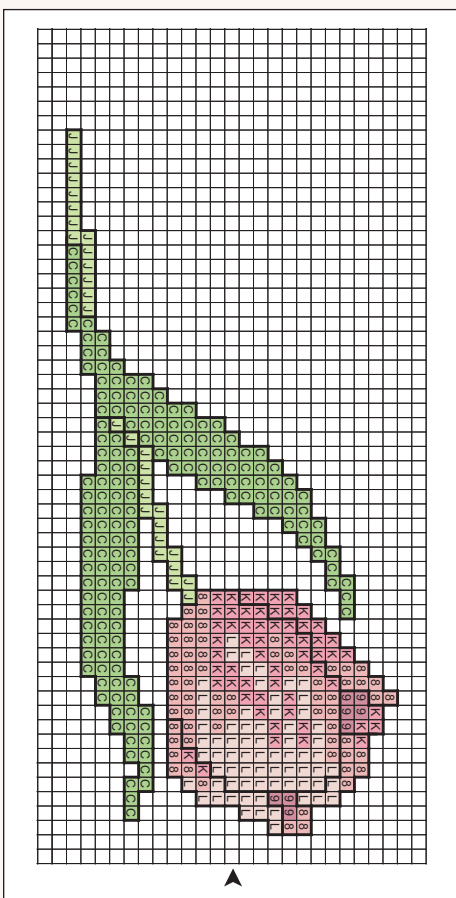
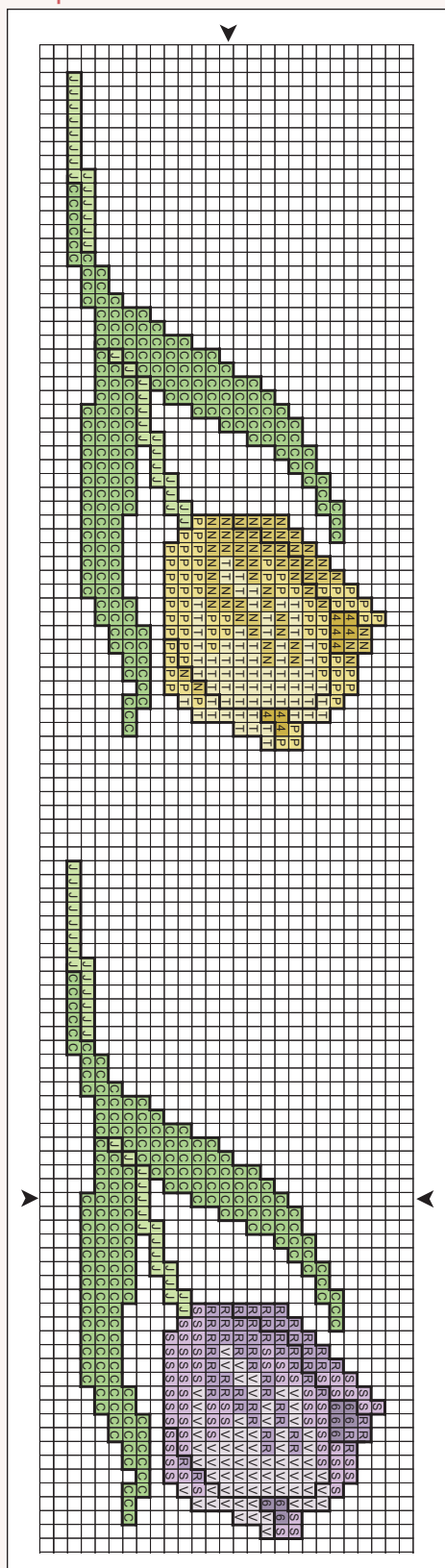

*Adding a bit of spring to your bathroom is easy with these floral guest towels. Stitch a single tulip on each towel or work a trio of tulips across the towel band — either way, your guests will be impressed with the special handmade touch.*

**Tulip Trio Stitch Count**

163w × 23h

**Single Tulip Stitch Count**

49w × 23h

**Fabric**

One 12" × 19½" White Maxton™ Velour Guest Towel with 14ct. Aida cloth panel by Charles Craft

**Tulip Trio Design Size**

14ct. = 11⅝" × 1⅝"  
(29.5cm × 4.1cm)

**Single Tulip Design Size**

14ct. = 3½" × 1⅝"  
(8.9cm × 4.1cm)

**Instructions**

Center the design on the Aida cloth panel and begin stitching. (You can choose to stitch all three tulips on one towel or a single tulip on the center of the Aida cloth panel, as shown in the photograph.) Work cross-stitches with three strands of cotton embroidery floss. Work backstitches with two strands of cotton embroidery floss.
