77% acrylic, 23% polyamide 100g/33 yds

Ruffles make this scarf fun to wear. But the amazing part of this scarf is how it's made. The ribbon is completely flat, with "boxes" on one end. Using a combination of Tunisian Crochet and "knitting" with a crochet hook, you have no ends to weave in when you are done!

Materials

Size L (7mm) Tunisian Crochet Hook with cable (must have a removable cap at the end)

Note: All stitches are worked through the edge of the ribbon opposite the edge with the bubbles.

Step 1) Starting at edge, insert hook from front to back through ribbon. Yarnover by inserting hook 1 or 2 spaces to the left from last entry point. Complete first chain by pulling yarnover through loop on hook. Repeat steps 1-2, 3 more times – 4 chains.

Row 1

Step 2) Turn. [Insert hook in next chain and next loop of ribbon and bring up a loop] 4 times – 5 loops on hook.

Row 2

Step 3) Turn. Slide stitches onto cable.

Step 4) [Insert hook through the work from front to back (under the cable), and through the center of the stitch, yarnover and pull up a loop] 5 times. 5 stitches on hook, and 5 stitches on the cable.

Step 5) Turn. Pull cable so that all stitches remaining on cable slide off. Slide sts that were on the hook onto the cable.

Repeat steps 4 and 5 until scarf is desired length, and you have at least 7 loops left on ribbon to complete the final row.

Last row

Do not turn. Yarnover and pull through first loop on hook [yarnover, pull through 2 loops on hook] across, until 1 loop remains on hook. Fasten off by pulling a yarnover through the remaining stitch.

1 ball of Spectra will yield a scarf 54-60" long. For a longer scarf, purchase additional yarn.
