



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 6½"

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville Collection® *Everyday Soft Worsted Solid* for Premier Yarns® (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113gm/203 yds)

- #ED100-18 Cornflower (A) – 1 ball
- #ED100-01 Snow White (B) – 1 ball
- #ED100-27 Lemon (C) – 1 ball

Hook: US Size F-5 (3.75 mm) hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2 yards black embroidery floss, polyester fiberfill for stuffing, crayon or blush for cheek color

GAUGE

9 sc x 9 rnds = 2"

While gauge is not crucial for this project, work evenly and consistently throughout. Stitches should be firm and even, with no gaps for stuffing to show through. Change hook size if necessary to obtain a firm crochet fabric.

Directions:

PATTERN NOTES

Do not join rnds unless otherwise specified. Insert a contrasting piece of yarn or movable stitchmarker in the last st of rnd and move this up with each rnd completed.

Stuff pieces firmly, but do not overstuff and distort stitches so that stuffing shows through.

To change colors in sc, use working color to pull up a loop in next st, drop working color, yo with new color and pull through 2 lps on hook. Cut original working color and secure ends with a small knot.

PENGUIN

Head

Beg at nose, with B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 6: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 7: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in each sc around, changing to A in last st.

Rnd 9: * Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnds 10 and 11: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 12: * Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 13: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 14: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 15: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 16: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc. Stuff head firmly.

Rnd 17: * Sc in next sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 18: Sc2tog around, sl st in next sc; fasten off leaving a 12" yarn end – 6 sts.

Finish stuffing Head. Thread yarn end through yarn needle and weave through each st. Pull tightly to close opening. Knot yarn securely and thread yarn into the inside of the Head; cut.

Body

Beg at bottom of Body, with A, ch 2.

Rnds 1-4: Rep Rnds 1-4 of Head – 24sc.

Rnds 5-10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 12 (neck opening): * Sc in next sc, sc2tog; rep from * around, sl st in next sc; fasten off leaving a 12" yarn end – 12 sc.

Stuff Body firmly. Thread yarn needle with end and sew neck opening to Head (white area of head is Fernando's face).

Widow's Peak

With A, ch 11.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, turn – 10 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in next sc, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc, turn – 8 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last sc, turn – 5 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in next sc, draw up a loop in each of next 3 sc, yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook, sc in last sc, turn – 3 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, draw up a loop in each of next 3 sc, yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook, turn – 1 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in sc, fasten off.

Sew Widow's Peak to front of Head, using photo as a guide.

Beak

With C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around; at end of Rnd 4, sl st in next sc, fasten off.

Stuff lightly and sew to front of Head, using photo as a guide.

Wing (Make 2)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 8 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 10 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around, sl st in next sc; fasten off.

Stuff each Wing lightly. Pinch Rnd 5 closed flat and sew Wings in place on each side of Body, using photo as a guide.

Tail

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 8 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 10 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around, sl st in next sc; fasten off leaving a 12" yarn end.

Stuff Tail lightly and sew to back of Body, using photo as a guide.

Tummy

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: 2 Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around, sl st in next sc; fasten off – 18 sc.

Sew Tummy to middle of Body, using photo as a guide.

Foot (Make 2)

With C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 2: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: [Sc2tog] 4 times, sl st in last sc; fasten off.

Pinch Rnd 4 closed flat and sew each Foot to bottom of Body, using photo as a guide.

FINISHING

Using photo as a guide for all finishing, embroider eyes using a doubled length of black embroidery floss. Color cheeks with red crayon or powdered blush, if desired.

Weave in ends.
