



**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Length:** 16"

**Width:** 10"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier Yarns® Starbella Stripes** (100% acrylic; 100g/33 yds)

- 17-15 Teamwork (MC) – 3 skeins

**Premier Yarns® Merry** (67% polyester/33% metallic; 50g/87 yds)

- 1207 Dancing Flame (CC) – 1 ball

**Directions:**

**PATTERN NOTES**

Pom Pom is created by tying together lengths of yarn; there is no knitting or crocheting involved.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Using Starbella Stripes, cut 54 lengths of yarn 64" in length, work to end of each skein, leaving one yard from last skein for tying together at the end.

Using Merry, cut 48 lengths of yarn 64" in length, work to end of each skein, leaving one yard from last skein for tying together at the end.

**FINISHING**

Fold each length of yarn in half. Carefully line up together horizontally, alternating between Starbella Stripes and Merry yarns. Using last yard of Starbella Stripes, tie all yarns together at the center, wrap around 2 times and secure into a knot, creating loop for holding at the top. Cut each length of yarn at the 'fold' line, both sides should look the same and be the same length.
