



**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Chest Measurement: 24 (26, 28, 30)''

Length: 11 (12, 13, 15)''

**SIZES**

Child 2 (4, 6, 8) years

**MATERIALS**

**Deborah Norville Collection Cotton Soft Silk Multi** (78% Cotton, 22% Silk; 70g/126 yd)

- 955-04 Undersea Treasure 2 (3, 4, 5) balls – MC

**Deborah Norville Collection Cotton Soft Silk** (78% Cotton, 22% Silk; 85g/154 yd)

- 950-10 Turquoise 1 (1, 2, 2) balls – CC

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5mm), US Size 6 (4mm) 24'' circ or size needed to get gauge

**Notions:** Yarn Needle, Stitch Holder

**GAUGE**

20 sts x 28 rows = 4'' in St pattern on larger needles

**Directions:**

**STITCH GUIDE**

**Slip Stitch Pattern** (multiple of 2 + 4)

All stitches slipped purl-wise with yarn in back

Row 1 (RS): K2, \* sl 1, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2

Rows 2 and 4 (WS): Purl across

Row 3 (RS): K2, \* k1, sl 1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2

Rep Rows 1-4 for Patt St.

**VEST**

**Back**

With CC and smaller needles cast on 62 (66, 70, 78) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times, rep Row 1, 1 more time.

Next row: Purl across increasing 0 (2, 2, 0) sts – 62 (68, 72, 78) sts.

Switch to MC and larger needles.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work row 1 of Patt st.

Continue to work in Patt st until Back meas 6 (6.5, 7.5, 9)".

### Armhole

**Rows 1 & 2:** Bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts, work across row in Patt st.

**Row 3:** k1, k2tog, work across row in Patt st to last 3 sts, ssk, k1.

**Row 4:** Work across row in Patt st.

Rep rows 3-4, 2 (3, 3, 4) more times – 46 (50, 52, 56) sts.

Continue to work in Patt st until Back meas 10.5 (11.5, 12.5, 14.5)".

### Shoulders

**Rows 1-2:** Bind off 7 (8, 7, 8) sts, work across row in Patt st.

**Rows 3-4:** Bind off 6 (7, 7, 7) sts, work across row in Patt st.

**Row 5:** Bind off remaining 20 (20, 24, 26) sts.

### Front

Work as for back through Armhole shaping.

### Neck Shaping Left Front

**Row 1 (RS):** Work 20 (22, 23, 25) sts in Patt st, ssk, k1, place remaining 23 (25, 26, 28) sts on holder.

**Row 2:** Work across in Patt st.

**Row 3:** Work in Patt st to last 3 sts, ssk, k1.

**Row 4:** Work across in Patt st.

Rep rows 3-4, 8 (8, 10, 11) more times – 13 (15, 14, 15) sts.

Continue to work in Patt st until Front meas 10.5 (11.5, 12.5, 14.5)".

### Left Shoulder

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 7 (8, 7, 8) sts, work across row in Patt st.

**Row 2:** Work across in Patt st.

**Row 3:** Bind off remaining 6 (7, 7, 7) sts.

### Neck Shaping Right Front

Place stitches from holder back onto needle.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, k2tog, work in Patt st across.

**Row 2:** Work across in Patt st.

Rep rows 1-2, 9 (9, 11, 12) more times – 13 (15, 14, 15) sts.

Continue to work in Patt st until Front meas 10.5 (11.5, 12.5, 14.5)".

## Right Shoulder

**Row 1 (RS):** Work across in Patt st.

**Row 2:** Bind off 7 (8, 7, 8) sts, work across row in Patt st.

**Row 3:** Work across in Patt st.

**Row 4:** Bind off remaining 6 (7, 7, 7) sts.

## Arm Hole Edging

Sew side seam.

With CC and smaller needle, pick up 50 (54, 54, 58) sts along Arm Hole.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-2, 3 more times.

Bind off all sts.

## Neck Edging

Sew Shoulder seams.

With CC and smaller needle, pick up 19 (21, 19, 20) sts along the right side of the neck, 20 (20, 24, 26) sts along the back, and 19 (21, 19, 20) sts along the left side of the neck – 58 (62, 62, 66) sts.

You will be working in rows, do not join.

**Row 1 (WS):** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2 (RS):** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-2, 3 more times, rep row 1, 1 more time.

Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Sew any remaining seams. Sew the edge of the neck edging down so they overlap at the front center of the neck. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

**CC** contrasting color

**circ** circular

**dec'd** decreased

**k** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

**MC** main color

**meas** measures

**ndl(s)** needle(s)

**p** purl

**patt** pattern

**rep** repeat(ing)

**RS** right side

**sl** slip

**ssk** slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**WS** wrong side
