



SIZES

Small (Medium, Large)

Shown in Small Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 12 (14, 16)''

Width: 20 (22, 24)''

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville Collection® Everyday® Soft Worsted by Premier® Yarns (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113gm/203 yds)

- #ED100-23 Mist – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Citylife (38% polyester, 26% polyamide, 20% acrylic, 11% wool, 5% metallic; 50gm/140 yds)

- #CL-06 City Rain – 1 ball

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

Directions:

GAUGE

10 sts x 5 rows = 4'' in patt with both yarns held together

Save time, check your gauge.

SHRUG

With both yarns held tog throughout, ch 53 (57, 63).

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hk, * ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across, turn – 25 (27, 30) dc.

Row 2: Turn, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 now and throughout), * dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Rep Row 2 until Shrug meas 12 (14, 16)'' from beg.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold Shrug in half lengthwise. Sew 1½" sleeve seams. Weave in ends.
